INTRODUCTION

The Company had at its annual general meeting held on 28 May 2010 given the general mandates to the Directors to exercise the power of the Company to repurchase Shares and to issue Shares. These general mandates will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting. The Directors therefore propose to seek your approval of the grant of the Repurchase Mandate and the Share Issue Mandate, in accordance with the Listing Rules, to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the proposed Repurchase Mandate, Share Issue Mandate, extension of the Share Issue Mandate, the re-election of retiring directors, and to seek your approval of the relevant Ordinary Resolutions; relating to these matters at the Annual General Meeting.

GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE SHARES

The Company had at its annual general meeting held on 28 May 2010 given a general mandate to the Directors to exercise the powers to repurchase Shares. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.

An Ordinary Resolution will therefore be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate, details of which are set out in Ordinary Resolution no. 5A.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 4,303,881,194 Shares. Assuming that there is no change in the issued share capital between the period from the Latest Practicable Date and the date of passing the Repurchase Resolution, the maximum number of Shares which may be repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate as at the date of passing the Repurchase Resolution will be 430,388,119 Shares.

An explanatory statement as required under the Share Repurchase Rules to provide the requisite information of the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES

The Company had at its annual general meeting held on 28 May 2010 given a general mandate to the Directors to exercise the powers to issue Shares and authorised an extension of the limit of such general mandate by adding to it the number of Shares repurchase by the Company. Such general mandate will lapse at the conclusion of the Annual General Meeting.

Two Ordinary Resolutions will therefore be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to (i) grant to the Directors the Share Issue Mandate; and (ii) authorise an extension of the limit of the Share Issue Mandate so granted by adding to it the number of Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate, if granted.

Details of the Share Issue Mandate and the extension of the Share Issue Mandate are set out in Ordinary Resolution nos. 5B and 5C respectively.

RE-ELECTION OF THE RETIRING DIRECTORS

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the executive Directors were Mr. Shi Jian, Mr. Li Yao Min, Mr. Yu Hai Sheng, Mr. Jiang Xu Dong, Mr. Shi Pin Ren and Mr. Yue Wai Leung, Stan; the non-executive Directors are Mr. Cheung Wing Yui and Mr. Jin Bing Rong; and the independent non-executive Directors are Mr. Jiang Xie Fu, Mr. E. Hock Yap and Mr. Zhuo Fumin.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

Pursuant to the existing bye-laws 86(2), 87(1) and 87(2) of the Bye-laws, Mr. Li Yao Min, Mr. Yu Hai Sheng, Mr. Jin Bing Rong, Mr. Jiang Xie Fu, Mr. Zhuo Fumin and Mr. Shi Pin Ren will be retiring from their respective offices at the Annual General Meeting and eligible for re-election. Particulars of the Directors proposed to be re-elected in the Annual General Meeting are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

At the Annual General Meeting, the Ordinary Resolutions will be proposed to approve the proposed Repurchase Mandate, Share Issue Mandate, extension of the Share Issue Mandate, and the re-election of retiring directors. The notice of Annual General Meeting is set out on pages 14 to 17 of this circular.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN

A proxy form for use at the Annual General Meeting and any adjournment thereof is enclosed with this circular. If you do not propose to attend the Annual General Meeting, you are requested to complete the accompanying proxy form and return it to the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Tengis Limited at 26th Floor, Tesbury Centre, 28 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the proxy form will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof should you so wish.

VOTING BY WAY OF POLL

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules, all votes of shareholders at the Annual General Meeting will be taken by poll and the Company will announce the results of the poll in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors are pleased to recommend the retiring Directors, particulars of whom are set out in Appendix II to this circular, for re-election in the Annual General Meeting. The Directors consider that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate, the Share Issue Mandate, the extension of the Share Issue Mandate and the re-election of Directors, are all in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Accordingly, the Directors recommend that all Shareholders should vote in favour of the resolutions to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to give effect to them.

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Share Repurchase Rules, to provide requisite information to you for your consideration of the proposal to permit the repurchase of Shares up to a maximum of 10% of the issued share capital of the Company as at the date of passing the Repurchase Resolution.

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 4,303,881,194 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the Repurchase Resolution and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Resolution to repurchase a maximum of 430,388,119 Shares representing not more than 10% of the issued share capital of the Company.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and its Shareholders as a whole. Such repurchase may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net assets and/or earnings per Share of the Company and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and its Shareholders as a whole.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its memorandum of association and Bye-laws and the applicable laws of Bermuda. Pursuant to the Companies Act, the amount of capital repaid in connection with a share repurchase may only be paid out of either the capital paid up on the relevant Shares, the profits that would otherwise be available for dividend or distribution or the proceeds of a fresh issue of Shares made for the purpose. The amount of premium payable on a share repurchase may only be paid out of either the profits that would otherwise be available for dividend or distribution or out of the share premium or contributed surplus accounts of the Company.

There might be an adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the Company's annual report for the year ended 31 December 2010 in the event that the Repurchase Mandate were to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

5. UNDERTAKING

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will exercise the powers of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate and in accordance with the Listing Rules, the memorandum of association and Bye-laws of the Company and any applicable laws of Bermuda.

None of the Directors nor, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, their associates (as defined in the Listing Rules), have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company under the Repurchase Mandate if such is approved by the Shareholders.

No connected persons (as defined in the Listing Rules) have notified the Company that they have a present intention to sell Shares to the Company, or have undertaken not to do so, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

6. TAKEOVERS CODE

If on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Ms. Si Xiao Dong and Mr. Shi Jian (the spouse of Si Xiao Dong), a director of the Company, together with SRE Investment Holding Limited (a company which is together beneficially owned as to 63% by Ms. Si Xiao Dong and Mr. Shi Jian) were beneficially interested in an aggregate of 1,955,650,045 Shares, representing approximately 45.44% of the issued share capital of the Company. Based on such shareholdings and in the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares under the Repurchase Mandate, the shareholdings of SRE Investment Holding Limited together with its associates in the Company would be increased to approximately 50.49% of the issued share capital of the Company. Then, Ms. Si Xiao Dong and Mr. Shi Jian together with SRE Investment Holding Limited could be required under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code to make a mandatory offer in respect of all the issued shares of the Company by reason of such increase.

Save as aforesaid, the Directors are not aware of any consequences which may arise under the Takeovers Code as a consequence of any purchases made under the Repurchase Mandate. The Directors will use their best endeavours to ensure that the Repurchase Mandate will not be exercised to the extent that the number of Shares held by the public would be reduced to less than 25 per cent. of the issued share capital of the Company. The Directors have no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate which may result in possible mandatory offer being made under the Takeovers Code.

7. SHARES REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company has not repurchased any Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) in the six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

The following are the particulars of the Directors proposed to be elected at the Annual General Meeting in accordance with the Bye-laws:

Mr. Yu Hai Sheng, aged 57, is the Co-Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of the Group. Mr. Yu obtained a Master of Business Administration from Shanghai University. Mr. Yu joined the Group in 1997. Mr. Yu had been manager of Shanghai Mechanical Engineering Company, factory manager of Shanghai Pioneer Mechanical Engineering Factory and chief of Industrial Planning Bureau of Shanghai Sports Commission. He has ample experience in the installation of electrical, mechanical and networking equipment and management. He also sits on the boards of various companies within our Group. Mr. Yu is the father of Mr. Yu Songming, the Assistant President and Deputy Director of CNTD.

Mr. Yu holds 5% equity interest in SRE Investment Holding Limited, the controlling shareholder of the Company, and otherwise does not have any relationship with any other Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholder of the Company.

Save as the directorship with the Company mentioned above, Mr. Yu has not held any other directorships in listed public companies in three years immediately before the appointment. Save as the directorship and the position disclosed above, Mr. Yu does not hold any other positions with the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Yu is interested in 6,235,987 Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. Yu has entered into a service contract with the Company for terms of three years from 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2013. Pursuant to his service contract, he is entitled to receive an annual director's emoluments of HK\$2,500,000. His emoluments are determined by the Board with reference to the Company's performance and profitability as well as prevailing market conditions. Mr. Yu is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the bye-laws of the Company.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Yu has confirmed that there are no other matters that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders in connection with his re-election and there are no information that should be disclosed pursuant to Rules 13.51(2)(h) to (v) of the Listing Rules.

Mr. LI Yao Min, aged 60, is the Executive Director and the Vice Chairman of the Company. He is concurrently the Co-Vice chairman and the Chief Executive Officer of CNTD. Mr. Li joined the Group in May 1993. From 1992-1993, Mr. Li worked for Shanghai Golden World Commercial Building Company Limited as general manager. Mr. Li has over 20 years' relevant management experience in construction, structure, planning and large scale real estate project development. He is a researcher in the Faculty of Real Estate at the Shanghai Finance and Economics University. He also sits on the boards of various companies within our Group.

Mr. Li holds 5% equity interest in SRE Investment Holding Limited, and is a director of the controlling shareholder of the Company and otherwise does not have any relationship with any other Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company. Save as the directorship with the Company and with CNTD mentioned above, Mr. Li has not held any other directorships in listed public companies in three years immediately before the appointment. Save as the directorship and the position disclosed above, Mr. Li does not hold any other positions with the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Li is interested in 5,172,220 Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. Li has entered into a service contract with the Company for terms of three years from 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2013. Pursuant to his service contract, he received emoluments to a total value of approximately HK\$1.5 million in 2010. His emoluments are determined by the Board with reference to the Company's performance and profitability as well as prevailing market conditions. Mr. Li is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the bye-laws of the Company.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Li has confirmed that there are no other matters that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders in connection with his re-election and there are no information that should be disclosed pursuant to Rules 13.51(2)(h) to (v) of the Listing Rules.

Mr. Shi Pin Ren, aged 47, is an Executive Director of the Group. Mr. Shi joined the Group as Vice President in March 2010 and was appointed as the Executive director in June 2010.

Mr. Shi graduated from the Shanghai TV University with a bachelor degree in finance, and is an economist. Before joining the Company, Mr. Shi worked in the Agriculture Bank of China as the head of the Chongming sub-branch and the Minhang sub-branch of Shanghai, the secretary of a Party committee, and the general manager of the Real Estate Credit Department of the Shanghai branch respectively. He has over 20 years of experience in banking and in administration.

Mr. Shi does not have any relationship with any other Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company. Mr. Shi has not held any other directorships in listed public companies in the last three years. Save as the directorship disclosed above, Mr. Shi does not hold any other positions with the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Shi does not have any interest in the shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. Shi has entered into a service contract with the Company for terms of 3 years from 2 June 2010 to 1 June 2013. Pursuant to his service contract, he received emoluments to a total value of approximately HK\$1,163,890 in 2010. His emoluments are determined by the Board with reference to the Company's performance and profitability as well as prevailing market conditions. Mr. Shi is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the bye-laws of the Company.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Shi has confirmed that there are no other matters in connection with his re-election that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders and there are no information that should be disclosed pursuant to Rules 13.51(2)(h) to (v) of the Listing Rules.

Mr. Jin Bing Rong, aged 62, is a Non-executive Director of the Company since 1 April 2007. He is also a member of the Audit Committee of the Company. Mr. Jin has over 20 years of experience in the banking industry and was the former Chairman of the Shanghai branch of Agricultural Bank of China. Mr. Jin has been with the Agricultural Bank of China since 1984 and has served as the Chairman of its branches throughout various districts in Shanghai during his 20-plus year career. Mr. Jin received a bachelor's degree from Fudan University in Shanghai in 1984.

Mr. Jin does not have any relationship with any other Directors, senior management, substantial shareholders or controlling shareholders of the Company. Mr. Jin has not held any other directorships in listed public companies in the last three years. Save as the directorship disclosed above, Mr. Jin does not hold any other positions with the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Jin does not have any interest in the shares of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Futures Ordinance. Mr. Jin has entered into a service contract with the Company for terms of two years from 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2012. Pursuant to his service contract, he received emoluments to a total value of approximately HK\$330,000 in 2010. His emoluments are determined by the Board with reference to the Company's performance and profitability as well as prevailing market conditions. Mr. Jin is subject to retirement by rotation and re-election in accordance with the bye-laws of the Company.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Jin has confirmed that there are no other matters in connection with his re-election that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders and there are no information that should be disclosed pursuant to Rules 13.51(2)(h) to (v) of the Listing Rules.

Mr. Zhuo Fumin, aged 59, was appointed as an Independent Non-Executive Director of the Group in November 2010. He was also a member of the audit committee and a member of the remuneration committee of the Company.

Mr. Zhuo graduated from Shanghai Jiaotong University of Engineering Science in 1983 and obtained a master degree in Economics from Fudan University in 1997. Mr. Zhuo has more than 30 years of experience in the field of fund management and capital markets. Between 1987 and 1995, Mr. Zhuo served senior positions including an office head and an officer assistant of the Shanghai Economic System Reform Committee. Between 1995 and 2002, Mr. Zhuo held various senior positions at Shanghai Industrial Investment (Holdings) Co., Ltd., including the chief executive officer and the vice chairman of Shanghai Industrial Holdings Limited, a company listed on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "Stock Exchange")(stock code: 363) and the chairman and an executive director of SIIC Medical Science and Technology (Group) Limited, a medical company. From 2002 to 2005, Mr. Zhuo was the chairman and the chief executive officer of Vertex China Investment Co.,

Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of Vertex Management Group which is a global venture capital management company. In 2005, Mr. Zhuo co-founded SIG Capital Limited, an investment fund which focuses primarily on consumer products, new energy and health care sectors. Since 2008, Mr. Zhuo has been concurrently serving as a management partner of GGV Capital, a venture capital fund.

Mr. Zhuo was previously an independent director of China Enterprise Company Limited, a company listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange (stock code: 600675).
